More space. . .

The **Space to Thrive** campaign will provide the solution to our space constraints.

We will breathe new life into two beautiful historic homes to replace our current cramped, inefficient rooms with an updated mission-focused, child-friendly space.

Volunteer Center **\$1,000,000**
North building

The Volunteer Center will house spaces such as the new Community Room, Welcome Center for Children & Families, Volunteer Training Room, and offices.

Advocacy Center **\$1,000,000**
South building

The Advocacy Center will house spaces such as the new Older Youth Development Room, Advocacy Conference Room, Reflection Deck, and Resource Library.

Welcome Center for Children & Families **\$500,000**

A warm and inviting space all visitors will see upon entering the Volunteer Center (north building). It will house the campaign donor wall, offer seating, and a small café space.

Community Room **\$500,000**

A newly-transformed space on the main floor of the Volunteer Center that will be utilized as both a conference room and community meeting space.

Volunteer Training Room **\$250,000**

Volunteers will finally have their own designated space for training, workshops and events.

Older Youth Development Room **\$100,000**

This new specially designed space for teens will offer our older youth the opportunity to comfortably engage in Older Youth Workshops, meetings with their CASA Volunteer, training opportunities and more.

Welcome Garden **\$100,000**

The garden is located at the front of the Advocacy Center and all visitors will pass through on their way to the front of the building.

Resource Library **\$100,000**

A warm and welcoming room for volunteers to prepare for Court, meet with staff and community members about a case, or choose books, toys, clothes and snacks to take on visits to their CASA kids.

Advocacy Conference Room **\$50,000**

A private, sound-buffering conference room for staff and volunteers to host case-related meetings during which highly sensitive information about a child’s abuse and neglect may be shared. This room ensures the privacy and confidentiality of the children we serve.

Health Room **\$50,000**

A room that offers a quiet, restorative spot for staff, volunteers or visitors to tend to personal health needs like taking a brief break from a difficult meeting or conversation, tending to lactation needs, and more.

Laundry Facility **\$50,000**

A room for older youth to do laundry while visiting CASA. Free laundry facilities and hygiene items are two frequent needs for our transitional-age foster youth.

Reflection Deck **\$50,000**

A restorative space for staff and volunteers to host a meeting outdoors, enjoy lunch or get some fresh air.

Technology Workstations **\$50,000**

New technology workstations enabling the children, older youth and families we serve to print important documents, search for jobs, apply for school and more.

Offices **\$25,000**

17 offices are available for naming opportunities.
