Program

*An alternative way to earn a High School Diploma,
for students in jeopardy of not meeting requirements to graduate with his or her class,
or whose class has already graduated.*

Requirements for Admission

- At least 17 years old (up to 20)
- Have no more than 16 credits from High School
- *(Behind classmates by 1 year of High School credits)*
- Attend 2-day orientation/enrollment session

Student Responsibilities

- Attend 15 hours of instruction per week
Instruction will include:
 - Completing U.S. Government, Health, and Personal Finance - *if not previously completed.*
 - MO and U.S. Constitution tests
 - Completing End of Course exams as applicable
 - Completing college interest activities - College fair and apply to 2 colleges
 - Preparing for and taking the ACT or ASVAB test
 - Preparing for and passing all subject areas of the HSE exam
- Maintain full-time student status by completing 15 hours of community service or employment per week.
- Complete 40 hours of community service before graduation, *as required of all graduating seniors in KCPS.*
